Instructions

- Quilt submissions are limited to (1) quilt per non-guild member and (6) quilts per guild member.
- **Items submitted in any judging category cannot have been shown in the Independence Hall Quilt Faire show in the past.** Entries must be created by the applicant, but may be quilted by others (Vintage or Acquired Quilts) are the exceptions.
- **One application and one photograph per entry. Entries will not be accepted without a photo.** When making a hardcopy application, write your name & quilt name on the back of each photo.
- After completion of the application, you can send it by US mail or turn it in at a meeting.
- **Measure and record your measurements accurately!**
- Please rank your entry in order of importance (In case we cannot hang all entries received)
- All entries (except dolls, needle art, and wearable art) MUST have a 4" sleeve at the top for hanging. Fold a 9" strip, sew to form a long tube, turn, and sew to the top back of the quilt. ALSO anchor the sleeve bottom to the quilt.
- Sew a fabric label with the item title and your name to the bottom back corner, either side.
- If you cannot show your entry after you have submitted your application, or if you find you have given incorrect measurements, please contact Jocelyn Muncaster at 415-310-4804 or Candy Gutierrez at 408-621-4436
- Entrants will be judged by those attending the faire. Viewer's Choice Ribbons will be awarded.
- **All entries must be delivered to Calaveras County Fairgrounds, 2465 Gun Club Rd, on Wednesday, October 14, 2026, between 9:00 am and 11 am.** You will be given a receipt for each item, and you must have that receipt to claim your item(s). No item will be returned without a receipt.
- The show will close at 4:00 PM on Sunday, Oct 18th, when we will start taking down the quilts. **Starting at approximately 4:30 pm**, people picking up quilts will be allowed in, a few at a time. **Pick up will end at 5:30 pm.**

Categories -

Bed Quilt – Any quilt designed to be on a bed or act as a blanket

- Large bed quilt - One side measures more than 70."
- Medium bed quilt – All sides measure less than 70."

Wall Quilt – Any quilt designed to be hung on the wall as decoration.

- Medium / Large wall quilt – One side measures 36" or more
- Small Wall quilt- All sides are less than 36."

Beginner Quilt – New quilters can submit quilts in the beginner category for 2 years.

Youth Quilt – Anyone age 16 and under can submit a quilt in the youth category. Quilts will not be judged.

Vintage or Acquired quilts – Quilts will not be judged.

Dolls - please include a stand

Wearable Art

Blast from the Past (NEW Category!) – We know that many of the previous quilts entered in the past are worth a second look. Quilters can enter their favorite or an award-winning quilt for another viewing. Eligible quilts should have been previously displayed in our quilt show 5 years ago or longer. This category will not be judged as part of the show.

Insurance

Insurance is the sole responsibility of the entrant. Independence Hall Quilters and Calaveras County Fairgrounds assume no liability for the quilts and cannot be responsible in the unlikely event that a quilt is damaged or lost. Staff and volunteers are on hand throughout the show, and the exhibit hall is locked overnight. Submission of a quilt to the Mountain Heirloom Quilt Faire constitutes permission by the entry owner for photographs, which may be published.
